- Claims can only be made for purchases made within the eligible period which closes 30 June 2010

Note: The rebates are for residences only, not businesses or institutions
FOR TENANTS (of rented premises) please provide documentation eg a copy of your tenancy agreement or a recent electricity bill, showing proof of address (document must include both name and property address)
Claims must be submitted within 21 days of the date of purchase
Claims can only be made to Council, not at the retail store

What Council Offers and the Conditions

Why Does Council Offer the Rebate?

- To encourage people to buy water efficient devices that they wouldn't have bought otherwise
- To offer the amount of money that reflects the value of water saved

Terms and Conditions

These terms and conditions apply from 1 July 2009.

Eligibility

- 1) An **eligible customer** is a residential customer of Goulburn or Marulan whose property is connected to the reticulated water supply and who has purchased and installed eligible water saving products for the serviced property from 1 July 2009. Claims must be submitted within 21 days of the date of purchase.
- 2) **Eligible customers** can claim only a limited number of each "Rebate Type" for each eligible property that they own or occupy. The products eligible for rebate are: 3 star dual-flush toilets or better, 3 star showerheads or better and 4 star washing machines or better.
- 3) For any household (under the new or old scheme) the limit is 1 washing machine, 2 dual flush toilets and 2 showerheads.
- 4) To claim a rebate, complete the relevant application form along with the original receipt(s) from your purchase(s) and any other specified information set out on the front of this form.
- 5) To qualify for the rebates, original receipts dated between 1 July 2009 and 30 June 2010 must be provided with the application.

Toilets and Showerheads

- 6) To receive a \$50 rebate for a dual-flush toilet, the new toilet must be 3 star rated (6/3 litres) or better and replace an existing less efficient toilet system, including an upgrade from a 9/4.5 litre to 6/3 litres or better.
- 7) To be eligible for a \$50 rebate for a dual-flush toilet, the new toilet must be installed by a licensed plumber and a copy of the plumber's invoice or signature/license number must be provided.
- 8) To receive a \$20 rebate for a showerhead, the product installed must be 3 star rated (use 9 litres of water or less per minute) or better
- 9) Only 2 showerhead rebates may be claimed for each eligible property owned or occupied.

at-a-glance rebate guide

REBATE TYPE BUY FIRST - THEN CLAIM

1. Showerheads \$20

(limit 2 per property)

Must be 3 star rated or better.

2. Dual-flush Toilet \$50

(limit 2 per property)

Must be installed by a licensed plumber. Must be a 6/3 flush or better toilet and replace an existing less efficient toilet (eg single-flush toilet or 9/4.5 litre dual-flush toilet).

Rebate payable for cistern or full toilet suite

3. Washing Machine \$200

(limit 1 per property)

Must be 4 star rated or better.

Please ensure the machine is operated on the efficient cycle (as displayed on the Water Rating label) as often as is practical



Terms and Conditions cont'd

Washing Machine

- 10) To receive a \$200 rebate for a washing machine, the washing machine must be 4 star rated or better.

General

- 11) This rebate scheme applies only to fittings and appliances certified under the National Water Efficiency Labelling Standards Scheme (WELS) in accordance with the WELS Act (2005) and associated Regulations and labelled as such.
- 12) Goulburn Mulwaree Council expressly disclaims any contractual or other form of liability to any person in respect to goods and services in this leaflet.
- 13) Applicants must repay any Rebates provided if any of these terms and conditions are found to have been breached.
- 14) Toilets and showerheads installed in new houses are required to satisfy a BASIX certificate and are **not eligible** for the rebate.
- 15) Council reserves the right to make occasional inspections of the premises and rebated fixtures.
